

# THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG

**Guidelines to non-HKU students who are holding a valid student visa (NOT Dependant visa) studying in Hong Kong, and wish to take up HKU credit-bearing summer/short-term course(s) which is/are credit-transferrable to your home institute:**

## **For PASSPORT holders:**

You are NOT required to apply for additional student visa for participating in HKU summer/short-term course(s), as long as the current visa could cover the period of study in HKU. Please duly check the “landing slip” for the expiry date of your current visa.

## **For EXIT-ENTRY PERMIT (港澳通行證) holders:**

**You MUST obtain a “No Objection Letter” (NOL) from the Hong Kong Immigration Department (ImmD) for attending the HKU summer/short-term course:**

Upon receiving the admission offer from HKU, you should (1) seek a supporting letter from your main visa sponsor (at the university/tertiary institute you are studying in), and (2) submit the supporting letter and the HKU offer letter to ImmD for the “NOL” application. \*Please note the documents submission should be done by your main visa sponsor.

Once you obtained a “NOL”, please send a copy to [HKU Summer Institute](#) before starting the HKU summer/short-term course.
